Introduction:

Knowledge The course is designed to address the needs of a busy executive that has limited time to get to know the requirements of ISO 14001:2015. The interpretation of every clause of the standard targets those who have very limited or no understanding of ISO 14001.

The clauses of the standard are explained using the context of a business environment but may be applied to any organisation irrespective of type or size.

- Familiarity with the requirements of the standard at the level required to make informed implementation decisions.
- Understand the obligations of top management.
- Satisfy the ISO 14001 requirements for awareness training relating to the standard.

- Top management.
- Anyone in a management or supervisory role that manages business processes subject to requirements of the standard.
